Between this and our previously upgraded wet areas the inside will be looking fabulous - fresh, light and organised.

WREMO Meeting

Last Thursday there was a meeting with the Wellington Regional Emergency Management Office in the hall. It was disappointing to see so few people attending the meeting. In the event of a natural disaster the Mauriceville community would likely have to fend for themselves for several days, especially if there is damage to roading and infrastructure. Recent weather events have seen communities seriously impacted and isolated from support so it is important that as a community you are aware of how you can support each other. WREMO don't provide a store of bedding, food or supplies, that is up to the community to source these from their homes and to find people to take on support roles in their own community. The hall is the community hub, and will be open in the event of an emer-

gency.

There was also lots of useful information shared on how to plan and prepare your household for an emergency situation - no power, no water, no working toilets and you may not be able to get out.
