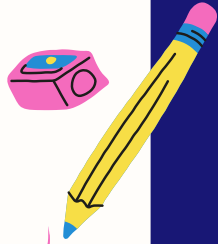

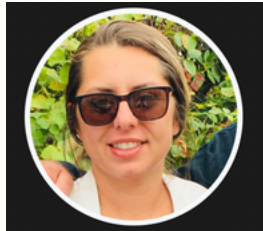

Swimming and Ripa Rugby Photos



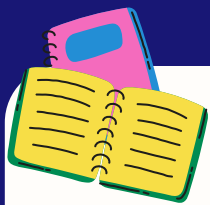
Over the past 2 weeks we have had our school swimming lessons. Everyone is having fun and improving with their skills and confidence.
