## Winter Ills and Chills

Thank you to our families for keeping children at home when they are unwell, and for ensuring they are well enough before returning to school, it really helps to minimise spread of illness.

Here's a guide from the Ministry of Health:

#### **Tummy Bugs**

<u>Early Symptoms</u>: Nauesea, diarrhoea &/or vomiting - 1-2 days from exposure to sickness.

Exclusion from school: Until well and 48 hours after the last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea.

#### Influenza & Influenza-like illness

<u>Early symptoms:</u> sudden onset of fever with cough, sore throat, muscular aches and a headache - 1-4 (ave about 2 days) from exposure to sickness. Exclusion from school: until well.

## Oral Health Message

#### **First Teeth:**

Start brushing gums before baby teeth come through, using a soft cloth and a small amount of fluoride toothpaste. This gets baby use to good habits as well as flavours and textures of the toothpaste. Check your child's molars regularly to ensure they look clean and healthy.
